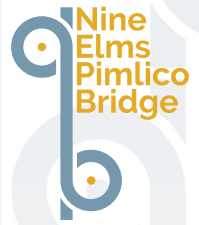


Public Exhibition Invitation

The project team for the Nine Elms Pimlico Bridge would like to invite you to examine outline proposals for an integrated pedestrian and cycle bridge crossing the River Thames which could connect Pimlico and Nine Elms, Battersea.

The event will highlight the various different landing point options on the southern and northern banks of the river, and explain how the project's feasibility and business case is being developed and updated.

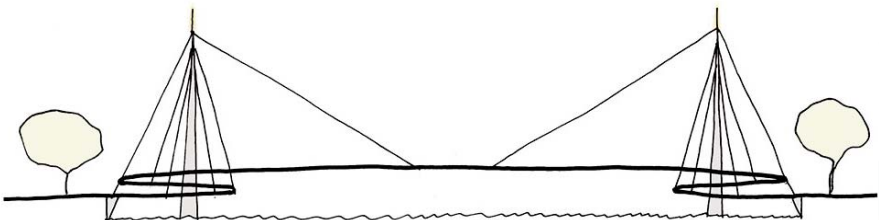
